


MARKET REPORT

10 months down and 2 months to go before we finish selling your 2017 crop. It's crazy to think that your 2018 crop is 60+/- days away. Valley Harvest Nut began prepping for the next season a few weeks ago. Just a reminder, if you are switching shellers, please let us know so we can deliver bins to the correct facility.

Let's talk about the current market. Although shipments were up from this time last year, May 2017 is the first month since September that shipments failed to set a new record. As you know, the shipment report is a sum of export and domestic shipments. Export shipments reported the lowest shipments this season, but domestic shipments were the opposite. Domestic shipments set a new record at 66.29 million pounds. Valley Harvest Nut is proud to be part of the United States of America shipments. (Statistic buffs, May 2017 domestic shipment number is outshined by only three other months in the past nine years. The #1 shipment was 73.3 million pounds <u>last month</u>.)

The industry's inventory is depleting as it should; brokers and customers express that it is nearly impossible to locate a few items, especially Carmel & Carmel-type almonds. The industry has shipped 71% of the crop and has an additional 15% committed to sell. Prices are consistent and holding.
